

2017 Renegades Spring AAU Girls Fees as of 1-5-17 (see below for Boys Fees)

- 175.00 Yearly club membership due now if not previously paid. All Spring AAU players must pay the full amount regardless of time of year they are back at the club. All AAU players pay the same amount which covers Sept 1, 2016 through Aug 31, 2017 this rate cannot be reduced. Includes drills, practice rental, coach fees, & AAU Insurance. Due at first evaluation for spring team.

Uniform Fee - For Brand New Players only, fee due at first evaluation for spring teams (Returning players may be required to purchase uniform if number was used in your absence or style was discontinued.):

- 120.00 Uniform fee due at or by 1st tryout your child attends - grades 6th and older
- 50.00 Uniform fee due at or by 1st tryout your child attends - grades 5th and under

NOTE: Wildwood and College Showcases are additional and applicable when coach determines roster and all have paid determined amount dependent upon number of players attending. The Wildwood tournament is \$100 per player if a minimum of 10 players attend.

- 175.00 July 5-8 USA Invitational College Showcase due now for older teams if attending (Lancaster Area)
- 150.00 Raffle & Bingo fundraising fee due by March 1st. (If you sell these to others you reimburse yourself to cover this fee. Participation is required to cover \$150 that would have been added to your tournament fees.) Two bingo dates will be offered. A date may be cancelled if participation (RSVPs) is below 100 participants.
- 135.00 June Hershey College Showcase due by March 1st. (if applicable)
- 175.00 (for 16, 17 yr old) or 155.00 (for 12,13,14,15 yr old) July Washington USJN College showcase due by March 1st. (if applicable)
- 125.00 Yearly Bldg Gym Construction Donation, if applicable, due on Feb 1st prior to 2nd thru 5th year of AAU spring team participation. You can also opt to pay the total one time per family donation in full at one time or have a company/business sponsorship take care of this for you and have a ad posted in our gym. Please note that Renegades is qualified to receive this and any donations through United Way's Donor Choice Program through your employer's United Way Campaign. You can designate a donation to Renegades with our United Way Organization Code #16428.

NOTE: If your child attends additional regular season tournaments over the original 6 local, 2 travel which were paid in advance, you are under immediate obligation to pay \$76.00 per additional local tournament played and \$93.00 per additional travel tournament played. Wildwood and all College Showcases are additional except where noted and applicable when coach determines roster and all have paid determined amount dependent upon number of players attending. Thank you.

Tournament Fee Breakdown for Girls

NOTE: All fee totals listed below Include \$150.00 Raffle & Bingo fundraising fee. \$76 for each local tournament, \$93 for each travel tournament. Tournament fees are due by March 1st at the latest. - see below breakdown.

- 4th & 5th Grade Girls = \$478 total includes 3 local tournaments + Wildwood tournament & \$150.00 Raffle & Bingo fundraising fee (hotel & travel expense is additional)
- 6th Grade Girls = \$630 total includes 5 local + Wildwood tournament & \$150.00 Raffle & Bingo fundraising fee (hotel & travel expense is additional)
- 7th Grade Girls and Up = \$799 total includes 6 local, 1 travel tournament + Wildwood tournament & \$150.00 Raffle & Bingo fundraising fee (hotel & travel expense is additional)

NOTE: Girls tournaments are usually a 4 game format with 2 games scheduled on Saturday and 2 games scheduled for Sunday in the same weekend. There is on occasion, a tournament where the games are played as noted above as a 3 game guarantee, see above note for boys. Note that sometimes a team may opt to play 3 games in one day and not play the following day or the day before due to a holiday, SATs, or a prom, etc.

Special Note: Renegades teams will have the opportunity to host sites at "Home" Renegades hosted tournaments. This can provide team fundraising to help cover your spring AAU expenses and build team spirit. All Renegades teams are expected to be prepared to host a site in the Renegades Spring Rally and/or the Renegades Summer Rumble. Parents & kids (when age appropriate) will learn the skills to run the clock and keep score as well as provide a great experience for our guest teams.

All College Showcase or National tournaments are additional. Thank you.

Tournament Fee Breakdown for Boys

NOTE: All fee totals listed below Include \$150.00 Raffle & Bingo fundraising fee. Tournament fees are due on Mar 1st - see below breakdown. \$68 for each local tournament, \$88 for each travel tournament. College Showcases are additional and applicable when coach determines roster and all have paid determined amount dependent upon number of players attending. The Wildwood tournament is \$90 per player & Hoop Group at Spooky Nook in Lancaster is \$135.00 per player if a minimum of 10 players attend. All travel & hotel expenses are additional.

- 3rd Grade Boys = \$286 total includes 2 local tournaments & \$150.00 Raffle & Bingo fundraising fee
- 4th & 5th Grade Boys = \$422 total includes 4 local tournaments & \$150.00 Raffle & Bingo fundraising fee
- 6th Grade Boys = \$512 total includes 4 local + Wildwood tournament & \$150.00 Raffle & Bingo fundraising fee (hotel & travel expense is additional)
- 7th Grade Boys = \$580 total includes 5 local + Wildwood tournament & \$150.00 Raffle & Bingo fundraising fee (hotel & travel expense is additional)
- 8th Grade Boys and Up = \$716 total includes 7 local + Wildwood tournament & \$150.00 Raffle & Bingo fundraising fee (hotel & travel expense is additional)

NOTE: Boys tournaments are usually a 3 game format with the possibility of a 4th championship game on the Sunday of that weekend. Teams are scheduled for 2 games on the Saturday of that weekend and then 1 game on Sunday and done or on to play their pool championship game. Sometimes boys play a girls format tournament if hosted by a girls club and will be guaranteed 2 games for Saturday and 2 games for Sunday with no championship game, winners later determined by record. Note that sometimes a team may opt to play 3 games in one day and not play the following day or the day before due to a holiday, SATs, or a prom, etc.

This can provide team fundraising to help cover your spring AAU expenses and build team spirit.
